Andrew Harvey is a scholar of world religions, a visionary, teacher, sacred activist, and author of over 30 Books, including the acclaimed Way of Passion: A Celebration of Rumi, The Direct Path, A Journey in Ladakh, The Son of Man: The Mystical Path to Christ, and The Return of the Mother. He also edited The Gospel of Thomas, trans. By Stevan Davies. Andrew was born in south India in 1952, studied at Oxford University and became a Fellow of All Soul's College in 1973. He has devoted much of his life to studying the world's various mystical traditions. Andrew will lead us through the outrageousness and beauty of the sacred teachings of Jesus, and lead us into ancient Christian Mystical Practices. In the Gospel of Thomas, we come face-to-face with Jesus' alchemical secret of transformation called the kingdom of God: a passionate love-consciousness. In Jesus, we see, not a savior figure, but a sign of a new Divine Humanity radically empowered from within to transform the world.

Workshop: Living in the Heart Spiritual Practices for Sacred Activists

Sacred Activism fuses the most powerful fires—the fire of passion for God with the fire of the activist's passion for justice—into the birthing fire of a new humanity. In this workshop, Andrew will invite us to awaken the consciousness of the heart and to live with the heart's innate sense of sacredness and interconnection with all of reality. He will share his vision of the heart, drawn from the major mystical traditions and lead participants through 4 galvanizing heart practices taken from the Christian, Sufi, Hindu, and Tibetan Buddhist traditions. Emphasis will also be given to the practice of forgiveness and essential shadow work that enables the heart to be kept clear and open to Divine Grace.
